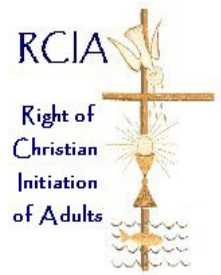


Ever thought of Becoming a Catholic Christian?

THE RCIA PROCESS is how you become a Catholic

“**RCIA**” means the **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults**.



PROCESS OF CONVERSION...about people being remade in the image of Christ, people being reborn in the Spirit, people on a journey toward Faith. The process stresses that conversion is begun by the Holy Spirit and is an extended process. The desire in your heart to become Catholic is a response to what the Spirit has already begun in you. Only God brings about the conversion.
